



MORGANA

Crochet Shawl by Kristin Omdahl

This is a spectacularly fun and festive use of colorwork and lace in a crochet shawl. You can make this gorgeous shawl in one color or use a trio of colors for extra fun! This top down construction hexagon-shaped shawl moves quickly with an easy to memorize stitch pattern. The color sequence and ornate edging are simple to learn and add a lot of dramatic flair.

What you will need:

650 yds (594m) of #1 superfine, fingering weight yarn

[TIDBIT TRIO kit Be So Fine by Kristin Omdahl](#)

Yarns: 100% bamboo; 215 yds (196m) per 1.3oz (36gm) ball.

color A: 215 yards shown in color Calypso Lime

color B: 215 yards shown in color Lavender's First Romance

color C: 215 yards shown in color Caribbean Turquoise

F/5 (3.5mm) crochet hook

Wrapture all natural delicate wash

Yarn needle

Scissors

Gauge:

5 dcs = 1" after blocking, but gauge is not critical for this project

Finished Size:

62 in (157cm) wide x 24 in (61cm) long



Stitch Glossary

Chain (ch): Wrap the yarn over the hook in a counterclockwise direction. Draw the yarn through to form a new loop without tightening the previous one.

Single Crochet (sc): Insert the hook into the work (or second chain from hook), wrap the yarn over the hook and draw the yarn through the work only. Wrap the yarn again and draw it through both loops.

Slip Stitch (slst): A slip stitch usually joins a round, or both ends of a row of chain stitches. Insert hook into joining stitch. Wrap the yarn over the hook from back to front. Draw the yarn through the stitch and through the loop on the hook.

Double Crochet (dc): Wrap the yarn over the hook and insert the hook into the work (or fourth chain from hook). Wrap the yarn over the hook,

draw through the work only and wrap the yarn again. Draw through the first two loops only and wrap the yarn again. Draw through the last two loops on the hook.

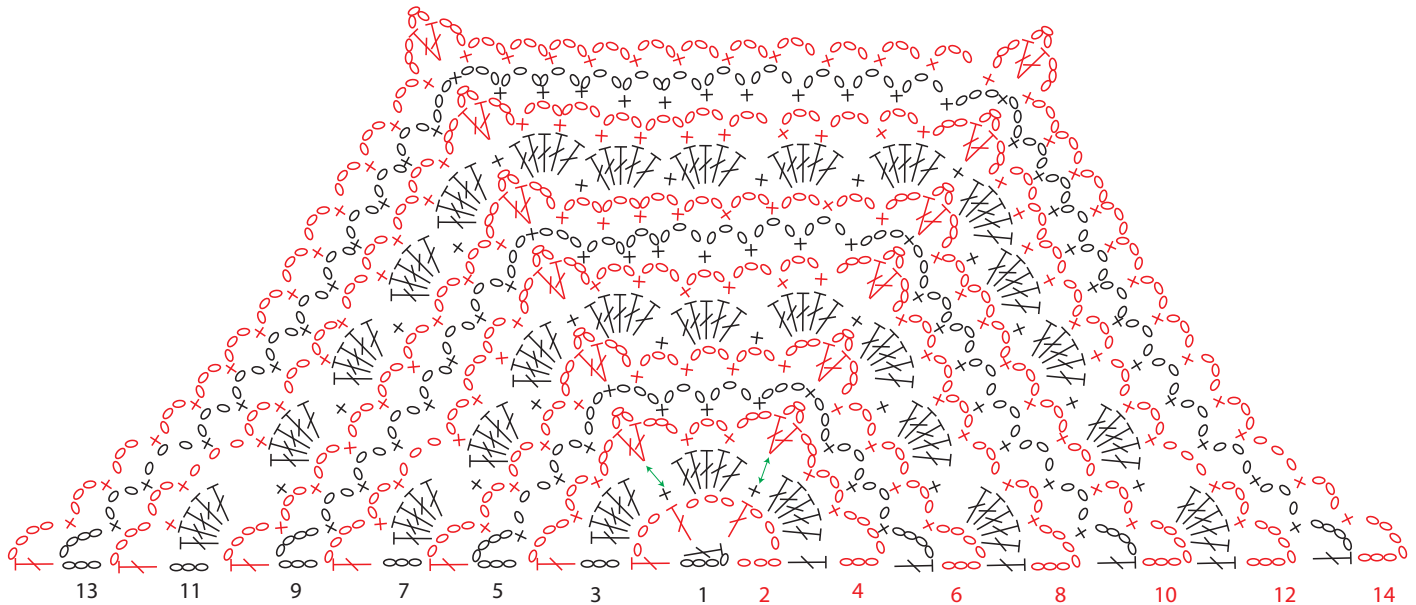
Treble Crochet (tr): Wrap the yarn over the hook twice and insert the hook into the work (or fifth chain from hook). Wrap the yarn over the hook, draw through the work and wrap again. Draw through the first 2 loops only and wrap the yarn again. Draw through the next two loops only and wrap the yarn again; draw through the last two loops.

SHAWL

repeat rows 11 - 14



INSTRUCTIONS:

Shawl:

Row 1: ch4, tr in 4th ch from hook. -- 1 foundation oval

Note: the color sequence shown is 1 row color A, 3 rows color B, 1 row color C, 3 rows color A, 1 row color B, 3 rows color C

Row 2: ch6 (counts as dc, ch3), [(dc, ch3)x2, dc] in oval. -- 3 ch3 sps

Row 3: ch3 (counts as dc), *5dc in next ch3 sp, sc in next dc. Rep from * 2 more times, on last rep, replace sc with dc. -- 3 5dc shells

Row 4: ch7 (counts as dc, ch4), skip 2 dcs, sc in next dc, ch3, skip 1 dc, sc in next dc, ch3, *(dc, ch3, dc) in next sc, skip 1 dc, sc in next dc, ch3, skip next dc, sc in next dc, ch3. Rep from * 1 more time, on last rep replace ch3 with ch4, dc in last dc. -- 2 (dc, ch3, dc) V sts

Row 5: ch7, sc in next ch4, sp, *ch3, sc in next ch3 sp. Rep from * across, ch3, sc in last ch4 sp, ch4, dc in last dc. -- 10 ch3 sps, 2 ch4 sps

Row 6: ch7 (counts as dc, ch4), sc in ch4 sp, (ch3, sc in next ch3 sp)x3, *(ch3, dc)x2 in next sc, (ch3, sc in next ch3 sp)x4. Rep from * 1 more time, ch4, dc in last dc. -- 2 (dc, ch3, dc) V sts

Row 7: ch3 (counts as dc), 5dc in next ch4 sp, sc in next ch3 sp, *5dc in next ch3 sp, sc in next ch3 sp. Rep from * 8 more times, on last rep replace sc with dc. -- 9 5dc shells

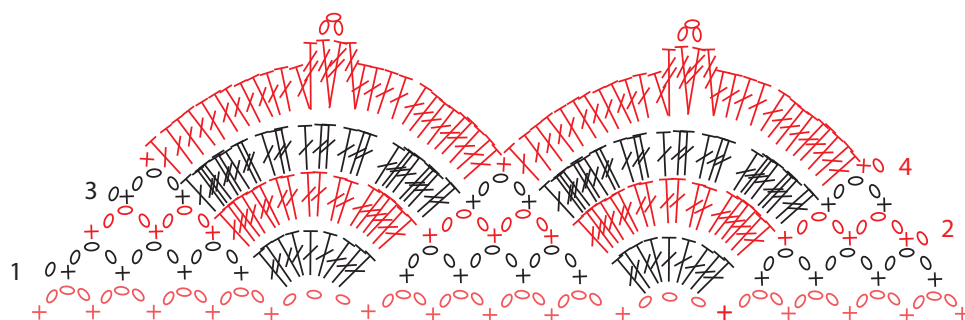
Row 8: ch7, skip 2 dcs, sc in next dc. *(ch3, skip 1 st, sc in next dc, ch3, skip next 3 sts, sc in next dc)x2, ch3, skip 1 st, sc in next dc, (ch3, dc)x2 in next sc. Rep from * 1 more time, (ch3, skip 1 st, sc in next dc, ch3, skip next 3 sts, sc in next dc)x2, ch4, dc in last dc. -- 2 (dc, ch3, dc) V sts

Row 9: rep row 5. -- 22 ch3 sps, 2 ch4 sps

Row 10: ch7 (counts as dc, ch4), sc in ch4 sp, (ch3, sc in next ch3 sp)x7, *(ch3, dc)x2 in next sc, (ch3, sc in next ch3 sp)x8. Rep from * once more, ch4, dc in last dc. -- 2 (dc, ch3, dc) V sts



EDGING



KEY

- chain (ch)
- ⊕ single
crochet (sc)
- ⌋ double
crochet (dc)
- ⌋ treble
crochet (tr)

Row 11: ch3 (counts as dc), 5dc in next ch4 sp, sc in next ch3 sp, *5dc in next ch3 sp, sc in next ch3 sp. Rep from * 12 more times, on last rep replace sc with dc. -- 15 5dc shells

Row 12: ch7, skip 2 dcs, sc in next dc. *(ch3, skip 1 st, sc in next dc, ch3, skip next 3 sts, sc in next dc)x4, ch3, skip 1 st, sc in next dc, (ch3, dc)x2 in next sc. Rep from * 1 more times, (ch3, skip 1 st, sc in next dc, ch3, skip next 3 sts, sc in next dc)x4, ch4, dc in last dc. -- 2 (dc, ch3, dc) V sts

Row 13: rep row 5. -- 34 ch3 sps, 2 ch4 sps

Row 14: ch7 (counts as dc, ch4), sc in ch4 sp, (ch3, sc in next ch3 sp)x11, *(ch3, dc)x2 in next sc, (ch3, sc in next ch3 sp)x12. Rep from * once more, ch4, dc in last dc. -- 2 (dc, ch3, dc) V sts

Rows 15 - 45: rep rows 11 - 14 (7) times, then rows 11 - 13 once more. -- 130 ch3 sps, 2 ch4 sps

Edging:

Row 46: slst into first ch4 sp, ch1, sc in same sp, ch3, sc in next ch3 sp, *(ch3, sc in next ch3 sp)x2, 9dc in next ch3 sp, sc in next ch3 sp, ch3, sc in next ch3 sp. Rep from * across, ch3, sc in last ch3 sp.

Row 47: slst into first ch3 sp, ch1, sc in same sp, ch3, sc in next ch3 sp, *ch3, sc in next ch3 sp, 2dc in ea of next 9 dcs, sc in next ch3 sp, ch3, sc in next ch3 sp. Rep from * across, ch3 sc in last ch3 sp.

Row 49: slst into first ch3 sp, ch1, sc in same sp, ch3, sc in next ch3 sp, *(2dc in next dc, 1dc in next dc)x9, sc in next ch3 sp, ch3, sc in next ch3 sp. Rep from * across, ch3, sc in last ch3 sp.

Row 50: slst into first ch3 sp, ch1, sc in same sp, 1dc in ea of next 12 sts, (dc, tr) in next st, (tr, ch3, tr) in next st, (tr, dc) in next st, 1dc in ea of next 12 sts, sc in nex ch3 sp. Rep from * across.

Fasten off.

Weave in loose ends. Hand wash with Wrapture all natural delicate wash, block to finished measruemets and let dry.
